Sin by Silence is a film about women who were imprisoned for killing their abusive husbands. Yet, despite prison walls, these women have helped change laws and lives of those dealing with abuse. The women share their knowlege about the warning signs of abusive relationships and make it very clear - we are all responsible and can no longer stay silent about abuse.

We are excited about helping you do something about abuse in your community. We want to help make sure your screening is a success so that your audience is inspired to take the steps to make a difference in their own lives, families and neighborhoods.

Follow the simple steps provided in this toolkit to secure a location for your event, order the DVD and screening license, invite your community and find out what is needed in your community.


The Sin by Silence filmmakers, as well as Brenda Clubine who is featured in the film are frequently available to attend screening events. Please contact our Outreach Coordinator at Brianna@QuietLittlePlace.com for further details, availability and fees.


In order to show the film at your event, we offer a reduced screening fee of $\$ 80$ for a DVD of the film and permission to screen the project in public. Also, included in the kit are an additional 4 DVDs to sell for $\$ 20$ at the event to help recoup your costs. So, by the end of the event, your up-front cost are covered! It's a win-win situation!

The event DVD is specifically designed to help create a great interaction with your audience. Along with the film, the disc includes a domestic violence statistics loop to play at the beginning of your event, as well as 2 great video message options to choose from for Brenda Clubine to give a message of inspiration directly to your audience.

Make sure to order the DVD screening kit at least 10 days prior to your event to ensure delivery. Go to www.SinBySilence.com/StopTheViolence and click on "Get the DVD" to agree to the terms and licensing fee.

Successful publicity helps get people excited about your event, while also raising awareness for those who aren't able to attend! You may want to creat an event on MySpace or Facebook to easily alert your community and invite them to come.

We recommend working and partnering with other local organizations so that you might expand your network and find out more about what is currently going on in your community. For example, a local shelter may need clothes donated. You can suggest that when people come to your event, they bring an item of clothing to donate. Your community may need signatures for a petition. Often you can help promote your event while promoting and partnering with others.

If you are planning a large event, it is also a great idea to send press releases to local media about your event and what you are trying to do. You will also want to create and print flyers to encourage your community to attend. * You can have a list of organizations that would be helpful for anyone in your audience that is in need of help from an abusive relationships.
* You can print out the handouts to give to your audience as they leave.
* You can order bulk rate DVDs to sell at your event to offset the cost and raise more funds.
